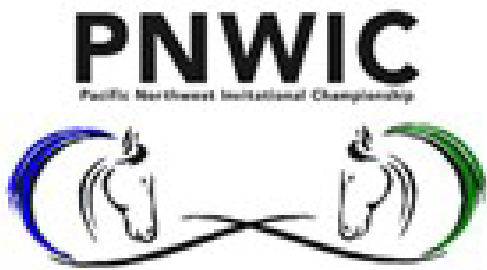

FAQs & INFO

- **PNWIC 2026 qualifier patch** should have been awarded at your state meet... if you did not receive it or still need your large PNWIC first time qualifier patch, request them from your district chair.
- **All athletes should come to the booth outside the PNWIC office and pick up your 2026 lanyard and schedule**
- **Will there be a place to lunge horses?**
Yes, there will be open arena each morning, and at sporadic times throughout the day. It will be posted on the schedule where and when arenas are available.
- **No outside shavings can be brought in... will extra bedding be available?**
Each stall will come with two bales of shavings. All stalls are matted on asphalt. Additional shavings can be purchased 3:00-3:30PM – Thursday, Friday and Saturday and 10:00-10:30AM Friday and Saturday. Bring \$10 cash/check with you when picking up shavings. Shavings are located in a cage near Barn 43.
- **Is it okay to keep hay in front of stalls?**
Yes.
- **Where will the Silent Auction be located?**
Each district should be bringing an item for the Silent Auction. Set up with be in the Ardell Pavilion. Set up should be completed by Thursday evening.
- **Where is the PNWIC office located?**
Inside the ARDELL Pavilion.
- **Can I park my car next to my Camper/RV/Tent?**
Yes, if there is room. Otherwise, you will need to park in the nearest lot.
NO HORSES are allowed in the campgrounds for any reason. You can park your horse trailers in areas around barns.
- **I have an issue with Stalls and/or event schedule, whom do I talk to?**
PNWIC Committee Members will be in the PNWIC shirts, however, go through your Coaches/District Chairs when possible. Classes are NOT running at the same time.
- **I signed up to volunteer for an event, where should I report.**
Volunteers will check in at the PNWIC office in the Ardell Pavilion.
- **What is the cost to stay over Sunday night?**
Sunday night camping would need to be reserved on the Grant County Fairground website. Stalls will be \$20
